Major Completed Work	Work in Progress	Next Steps
Major equipment installed: RTU's, electrical switchgear and generators, boilers, HVAC chillers, and elevators.	Interior door and hardware installation in all areas.	Windowsill and acoustic wall panel installations to begin.
Interior walls completed, painting, and glass.	Kitchen equipment installation.	Curbs/gutters and paving of the bus loop parking lot is ongoing.
Learning Stairs structure.	Learning Stair concrete pour.	Classroom furniture arrival and smartboard installation is expected.
Ceilings, lighting, and VCT and Ceramic tile flooring in academic areas.	Ceiling baffle installation, wood flooring acclimation, and rough cleaning in the classrooms.	Overhead door installation in the kitchen is ongoing.
Exterior storefront and entrance canopy.	Start-up of the RTUs.	Wood flooring installation in the gym, VCT installation in sector 2B, and ceramic tile installation at the locker rooms to begin.
Turf playing fields	Toilet partition installation in all bathrooms and locker installations in the locker room.	Landscaping around the site to begin.
Installation of gym equipment – scoreboard, basketball hoops.	Pouring of concrete sidewalks.	Building identification signage installation to begin.

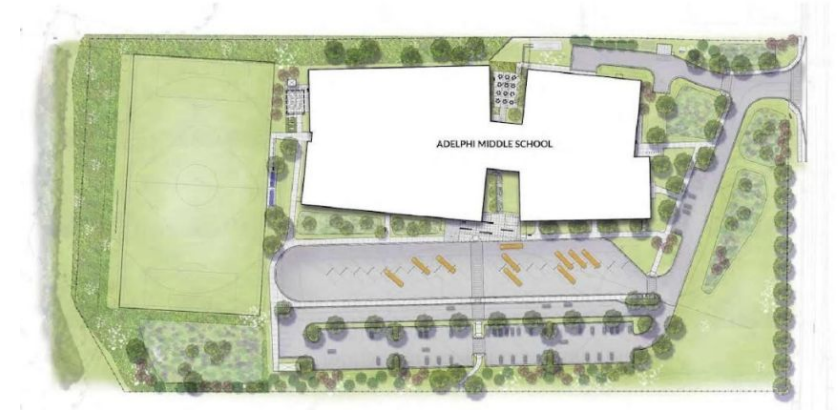
