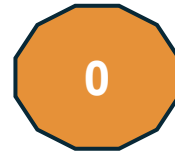

## What did we learn?

### Student Feedback

- 27.7% reported a need for emotional and mental health support
- 18.5% of students always see their culture reflected in their education.
- 75.4% of students felt that the school helps their families feel included/welcomed.

### Family Feedback

- 50% of families feel they don't have a need for additional support for behavioral and emotional needs.
- 50% of families felt their culture was reflected in students' education.
- 91.7% of families felt that the school helps their families feel included/welcomed.

### Staff Feedback

- 50% of staff felt their culture was reflected in students' education.
- 92.9% of staff felt that the school helps families feel included/welcomed.

## Priorities and Opportunities

- Expand tutoring aligned with classroom instruction
- Partner with local orgs for project-based learning
- Invest in arts, STEM, & enrichment for whole-child growth
- Support identity-affirming instruction with PD & curriculum resources

- Form diverse committees to co-design goals and advise initiatives
- Provide leadership and advocacy training for students, families, and staff

- Keep a centralized referral hub updated for support
- Keep an up-to-date asset map for quick access to local services
- Train staff and families on referrals

- Launch student affinity clubs and mentorship programs
- Form a Student Advisory Council to guide school decisions

- Create an engagement calendar with joint family-student-staff teams
- Use multiple outreach tools: texts, calls, apps, translations
- Host empowerment workshops on navigating the school system
- Offer "Bring a Friend" incentives to boost event participation
