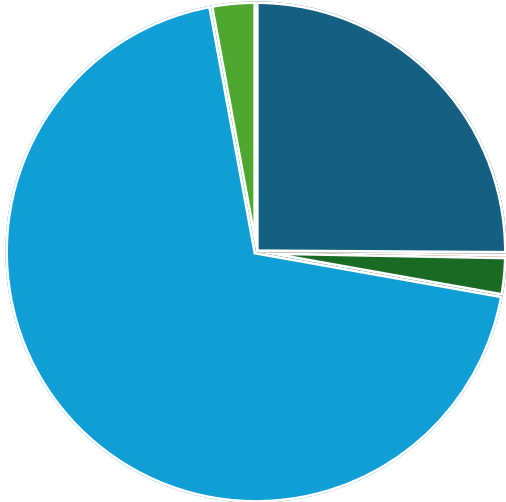
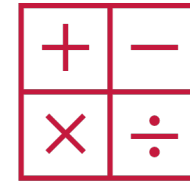

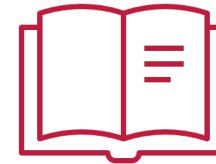

Student Feedback

- Reported feeling more supported academically when teachers provided clear expectations and regular feedback.
- Requested more extracurricular activities and enrichment opportunities that reflect their interests and cultures.



Staff Feedback

- Highlighted the need for more instructional resources and professional development in literacy and math intervention.
- Requested additional support staff to address student behavior, mental health, and classroom management needs.



Family Feedback

- Expressed a desire for increased communication from the school, particularly through multiple language channels.

Priorities and Opportunities
