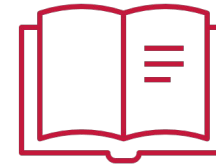

## What did we learn?



### Student Feedback

- (72.3%) reported- students in my school get along well with one another.
- (90.1%) reported- Teachers in my school like students in this school.
- (86.5%) reported- I feel safe in my school.



### Staff Feedback

- Staff generally hold positive perceptions of the climate and culture at Columbia Park Elementary
- Half of school staff members (50.0%) report that they frequently communicate to students and their families through e-mail or other computer-based electronic communications.
- 27.3% of school staff reported that their schools do have a parent leadership organization.

## Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



Columbia Park Elementary will work to provide quality, enriching after-school and summer programs to all students. This will result in increased student achievement in both math and literacy in grades 3-6.

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice



The Community Schools Coordinator, Parent Engagement Advocate, Professional School Counselor, and Mental Health Clinician will work in collaboration to ensure wrap around services are provided for students and families.

Integrated Systems of Support



Create partnerships with a mobile health clinic to provide on-site health services to students, families, and the community. Develop an information campaign to families about the importance of being present every day at school (flyers, talks at Back to School Night, posters, translated material, etc.).

Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care



Columbia Park Elementary School will increase health and wellness support for our students and families. This will be done by providing ongoing opportunities to access health and mental services and Family supports, during the school day as well as outside of the school hours, this will result in healthier students and families.

Powerful Student and Family Engagement



Ensure all information sent to families are translated in various languages and that interpreters are present at all family engagement events. Collect ongoing feedback from families and students to ensure we are maintaining a high level of engagement.
