


Summary of Student Feedback

- 69.5% of students acknowledge that they always are able able to do schoolwork or study at home using the internet.
- 40.5% of students acknowledge that sometimes they see their culture reflected in the education that they receive.
- 40.3% of students acknowledge that sometimes they see a connection between what students are learning in school connects to life outside the classroom.

Summary of Family Feedback

- 85.1% of families acknowledge that they always are able to do schoolwork or study at home using the internet.
- 70.1% of families acknowledges that the school has a Parent Leadership Organization.
- 62% of families acknowledges that your community school welcome everyone always.

Priorities and Opportunities Staff would like to have more apportunities to provide field trips to enhance

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities Staff would like to have more opportunities to provide field trips to enhance the curriculum that is being taught in the classroom.

Provide more field trips and enrichment opportunities for students.

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice 80.3% of Staff reported that their school has a Parent Leadership Organization.



Provide more opportunities for more partners and parents to participate in collaborative planning i.e. Steering Committee Mtgs/Sub Committee Meetings.

Integrated Systems of Support

24.4% of staff reported that they are unsure whether their school has the tools and processes for students to address their struggles with mental health.

10.2% of students reported that they "never" in response to the question asked "Can you/or your student get extra help with managing your feelings or worries if you need it?"



Provide more platforms for students to have access to mental health supports ie posting QR Codes in the Bathroom to scan to get support.

Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care Provide more opportunities for students to get access College & Career Readiness Programs ie through a Fair to enroll into CTE Programs



Provide enrichment opportunities to prepare students for post graduate college and career readiness through targeted service learning hours that align with interest i.e. Peer Mediation, Entrepreneurship, Writing Workshop for College Scholarship & Applications etc.
