


### What did we learn?



#### Student Feedback

- Many students feel the school prepares them for college and careers, but they could always use more help with academics.
- Many students reported they can talk honestly with adults at school. They believe the school welcomes everyone.

- The families have a high need for services such as food, clothes and legal assistance.



### Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice



Improve visibility and accessibility of parents leadership organization. Create student advisory groups, proactively include families and partners in decision-making processes. Have Community Partners to play a more active role with sharing leadership resources and their expertise.

Integrated Systems of Support



Expand access to on-site mental health, food, dental, and vision services. Establish clearer referral pathways and increase awareness of supports.

Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care



Continue reinforcing inclusive practices. Use student voice to assess and improve school culture. Prioritize staff-student relationships and trauma-informed practices. Continue to build our relationship with the Police Department Community Resource Officers that assigned to our school.

Powerful Student and Family Engagement



Increase communication using text and in-person channels. Clarify opportunities for families to engage beyond attendance—e.g., leadership, volunteering, workshops. Glassmanor Parent Engagement Assistant will continue to build relationships with Community Partners to address families needs.
