

#### Student Feedback

- 43.4% of students reported needing help with emotional support.
- 7.5% of students reported needing help with an afterschool program.



Staff Feedback

- 46.2% of staff reported that students need support with getting clothes and shoes
- 42.3% of staff reported that students need support

#### Family Feedback

- 11.8% of families reported needing help with emotional support.
- 43.8% of families reported needing help with food insecurity




Community Feedback

The school prioritizes utilizing various methods to collect data such as surveys and invite partners, parents, and students to decision making meetings.






A majority of families indicated that they could easily access and navigate supports offered by the school.
