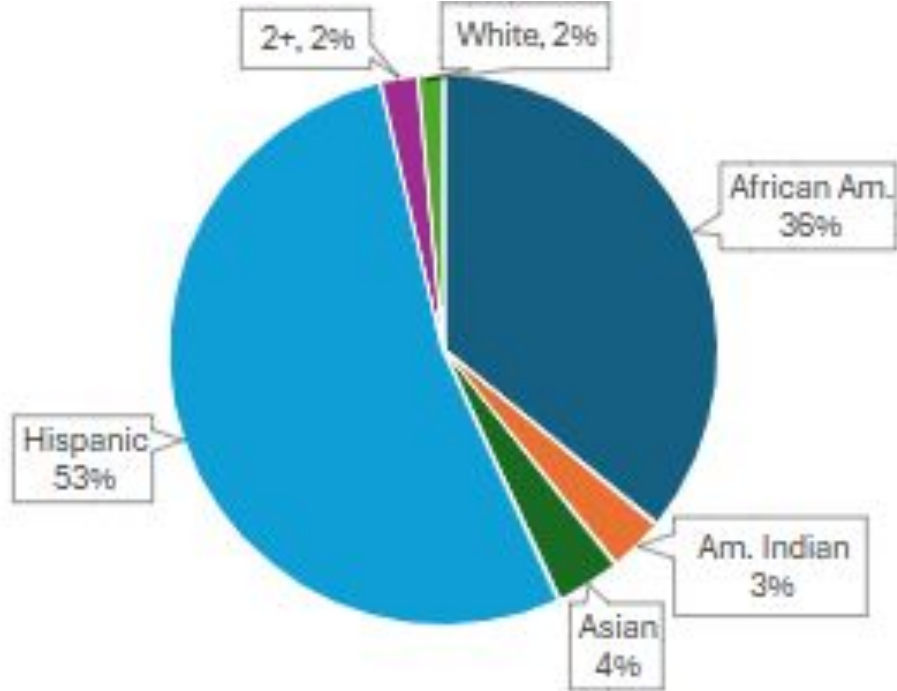
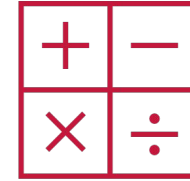

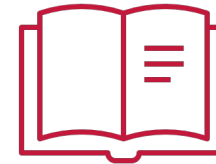

# Lewisdale Elementary School



## What did we learn?



- 64% of student see a connection between what they are learning and their life outside of the classroom.
- 80.4% said they could access extra help with schoolwork sometimes or always.



- Staff overwhelmingly report that tools exist to identify students struggling academically (89.5%) and with attendance (93%), but supports vary by need area.
- 63.2% of staff have worked at Lewisdale ES for six or more years, indicating a stable and experienced workforce



- Families prefer in-person communication (79.3%) and telephone calls (69%), with low preference for social media (9.8%).
- 76.5% of families feel included in the school community, and 82.4% say communication from the school is understandable.
