




Student Feedback

- 69.2% of students feel they have access to field trips, summer programs, and extended learning opportunities
- 48.1% of students felt that the school helps their families feel included.
- 48.1% of students felt that they could get extra help managing their feelings/worries.

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



Oxon Hill Elementary Community School will expand its academic support by increasing after-school programs and enrichment opportunities. The school will continue offering activities like coding and LEGO clubs to support STEM learning and student engagement. It will also maintain a strong focus on academics, the arts, and social-emotional and behavioral support. Community school funding will be used for student incentives, program materials, field trips, and enrichment activities.

Oxon Hill Elementary Community School will strengthen inclusive decision-making by building on its active Parent Leadership Organization (PLO). The school aims to remove barriers to engagement and encourage greater leadership from students, families, and community members.
