

- Communication Majority staff feels that the school communicate with families in the way that they understand.





- Relationship Majority families believes that the school always hold events for families and the community.




Use Bullets to Summarize Community Feedback

Priorities and Opportunities



- o Emphasis on expanded enrichment learning opportunities through field trips, cultural activities and in-school activities.
- o Increase educational and community resources to help with attendance and academic support.
- Provide enrichment activities for staff, students and families to improve academic outcomes.





- o Encouraging shared decision-making and teamwork among staff, students, and families.
- o Include representatives from different stakeholder groups (teachers, support staff, parents, and students where appropriate) on schoolwide committees.

Integrated Systems of Support



- o Increase students' and families' awareness of the various resources available to them in the community.
- o Expand community partnerships to increase access to support services for students and families.
