

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



Stephen Decatur Middle Community School plans to focus on continuing and expanding programming for in school programs and after-school programs to provide support in several areas (i.e. academics, social, emotional, and behavioral health, etc.) and summer opportunities. The school will also find opportunities to braid funding to provide students with more field trips and academic enrichment opportunities. Finally, community school funds will be allocated to fund materials for programming and student incentives.

Collaborative Leadership. Shared Power, and Voice



Identify and leverage students, families, and community members who would like to actively participate in family and community engagement opportunities within the school and remove barriers that may prevent them from participating. Stephen Decatur Community School plans to focus efforts on including all stakeholders in the school's decision-making process regarding students' achievement.

Integrated Systems of Support



Stephen Decatur Community School will find ways to leverage community school funds to create other student services positions and partner with outside agencies. Similarly, the school will seek to establish and strengthen collaboration with local organizations to provide the school community access to mental and behavioral health opportunities, education, and resources.
