Reminder: Upload Weekly COVID-19 Home Testing Results Today!




Please continue to test children and share results each week through Feb. 27. Two tests will be distributed biweekly.

As part of the proposal, students enrolled in Community-Based Classroom would be placed in one of the consolidated programs listed below:


Tall Oaks (Northern) – Annapolis Road/Tall Oaks would become a Grade 9-12 program located at Tall Oaks.

Croom (Southern) – Green Valley/Croom would become a Grade 9-12 program located at Croom.

Green Valley would become a Grade 6-8 grade program for middle school students.

Taking Applications for the Christa McAuliffe Award



Hyattsville Elementary hosted a special event for students to celebrate the 100th day of the school year.




