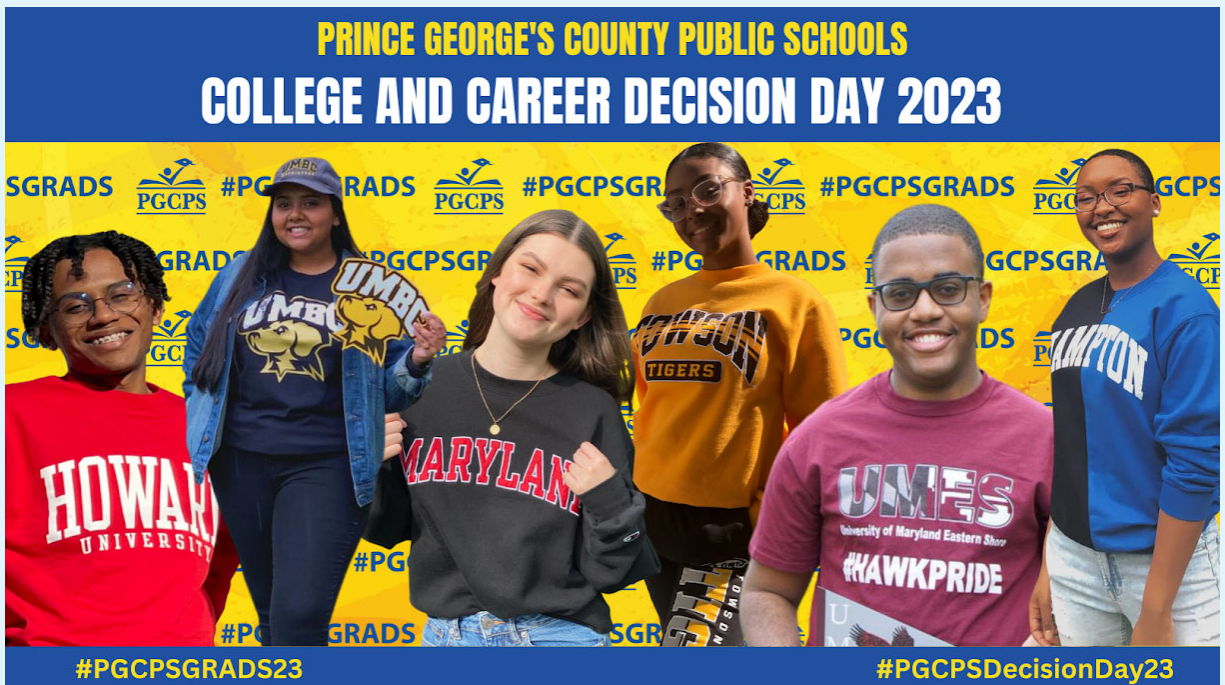

### Today is the Last Day of Student Transfer Season!

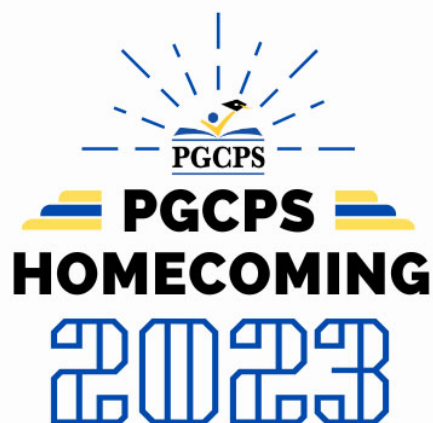

Transfer options are limited this year due to school boundary changes, sixth-grade restructuring and new school construction.
