



Today is the Last Day of Student Transfer Season!


As a reminder, today is the last day to submit student transfer requests! Parents and guardians of current PGCPS students can submit transfer requests electronically through the SchoolMax Family Portal until 11:59 p.m. Portal access is limited to parents and legal guardians with an active SchoolMax Family Portal account (username and password).

Transfer options are limited this year due to school boundary changes, sixth-grade restructuring and new school construction.

The Office of Student Records, Transfers and Archival Services will not accept transfer requests to schools that exceed state-rated capacity. View the <u>current list of schools with available seats</u>.
