1. Online

2. Next Week In-Person on Aug. 10 or 11

Register in-person at your assigned school on Wednesday, Aug. 10 and Thursday, Aug. 11 from 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. Please contact the school that your child will attend this fall to make an appointment.

To secure school bus transportation for the start of the school year your student *must* be **registered for school by Wednesday, Aug. 10**. Elementary school
