Telehealth Starts This Week in Some Schools



Through a partnership with the Prince George's County Health Department and Hazel Health, free healthcare services in schools are rolling out this week to students middle schools and academies on Oct. 10 and in high schools on Oct. 24! When students aren't feeling well at school, the school nurse can now initiate a telehealth v with a pediatric provider within minutes.

Parents will also be able to access Hazel free of charge Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. if their child becomes ill at home.

In November, the service will expand to include elementary schools, and will also include mental health teletherapy.

Be sure to sign the student access form so your child can access these health benefits. There will be a Hazel access button soon on school websites.


