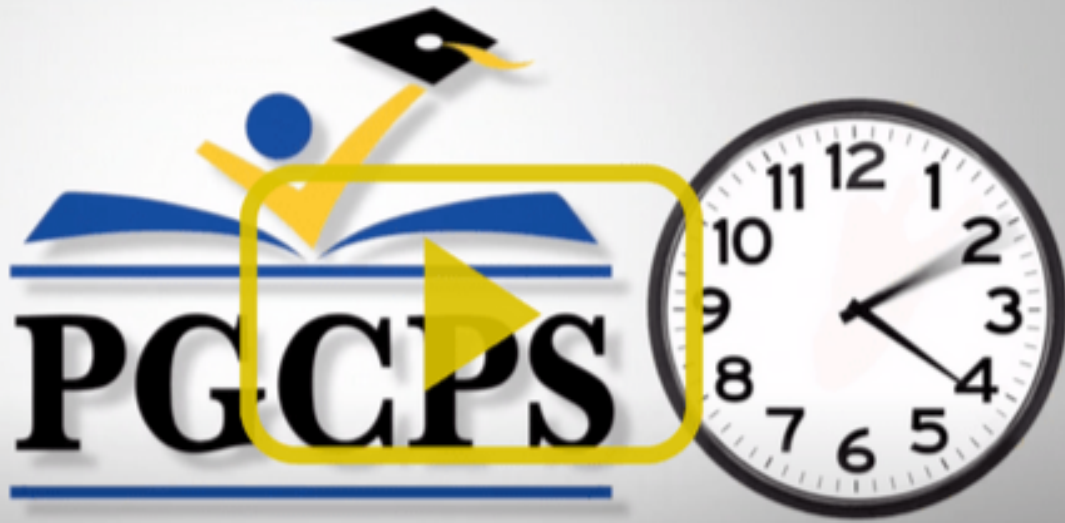
National School Bus Safety Week

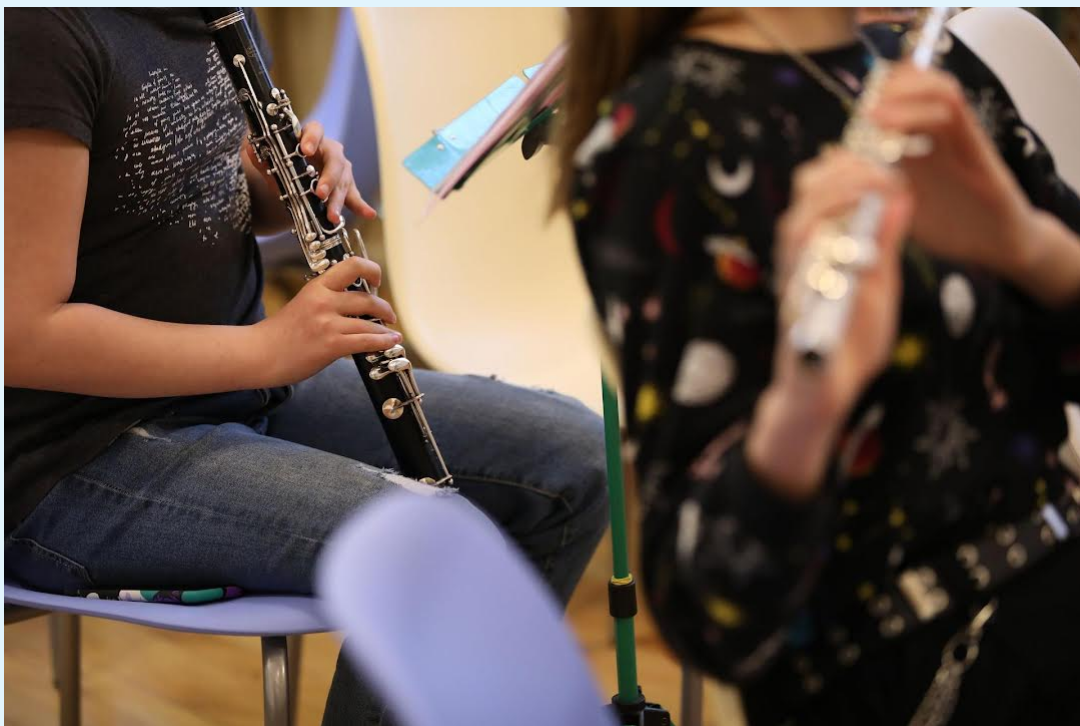
