

Safety First: Virtual Learning for Students Through Jan. 14



Amid a rise in COVID-19 cases in schools and [new quarantine guidance](#) from the Prince George's County Health Department, CEO Dr. Monica Goldson [announced](#) a temporary shift to virtual learning for all students. In-person learning will resume Tuesday, Jan. 18, following the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.

Students in the K-6 Virtual Learning Program will return Monday, Jan. 31. All athletics and practices have been postponed through Friday, Jan. 14.

Attendance During Virtual Learning



During virtual learning, students are expected to participate in live instruction to be considered present. In the event of an absence, a parent/guardian must communicate the reason for the student's absence with written documentation. Students will be permitted to make up missed assignments in accordance with the administrative procedure for all lawful absences.

Note: Students participating in virtual learning may experience technical issues such as broken equipment or internet outages that may impede participation in live instruction. Such issues must be immediately communicated to the student's teacher and designated school staff so support can be provided as soon as possible.

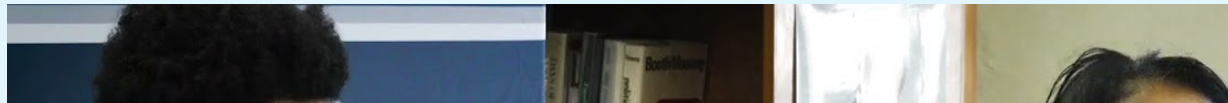
