


**Interpreters Available for Parent-Teacher Conferences**

#### **Share Input: Proposed Board of Education Policies**



As Board of Education policies are developed or revised, the public is permitted to provide input. On Sept. 22, the Board voted to approve the following policies for public comment before adoption:

<u>Draft policy 0109</u> - Financial Impropriety, Improper Conduct, and Whistleblower Protection

<u>Draft policy 3500</u> - Naming of Schools, School District Facilities, Dedicating Areas of School and School District Facilities or Grounds and Erecting Monuments

Draft policy 5113 - Student Attendance, Absence, and Truancy

The deadline for comment is Tuesday, Oct. 18 at 5 p.m. Comments on proposed policies may also be submitted by email to <a href="mailto:testimony@pgcps.org">testimony@pgcps.org</a>.
