Nearly 75% of PGCPS Schools Improve in Academic Achievement



The Maryland State Department of Education's latest <u>report cards and star ratings</u> show an upswing in academic achievement for most PGCPS schools! For the 2022-2023 school year, 72.4 percent of PGCPS schools received among the three highest ratings of 3, 4 and 5-star, an increase from last year. And when compared to the state average, more of our schools gained a star from last year, while fewer schools lost a star.
