

Public Hearing — Grade Structure Change

Potomac Landing and Ft Washington Forest Elementary Schools



PUBLIC HEARING

Prince George's County Public Schools will hold a public hearing to obtain public comment on two options under consideration for relieving over-enrollment at Accokeek Academy. More details are available at www1.pgcps.org/discussions.

Option 1: Create a K-8 academy at Potomac Landing Elementary School by constructing an addition for 400 middle school students. In addition to Potomac Landing Elementary School students, Ft. Washington Forest Elementary School would matriculate to this school for grades 6th through 8th. Potomac Landing and Ft. Washington Forest Elementary Schools would serve sixth grade until construction is complete.

Option 2: Construct a 600 seat middle school in the Fort Washington area to serve students in grades 6th through 8th from Potomac Landing, Ft. Washington Forest and Rose Valley Elementary Schools. Potomac Landing and Ft. Washington Forest Elementary Schools would serve sixth grade until construction is complete.
