# Art Class with Ms.0



In November, students in grades 3rd-5th will work on blending techniques to add shading, texture, and highlights to their artwork. They will also work on showing weather, time of day, and season in their landscape drawings based on their choice of color and detail. Students in grades preK-2nd will work on drawing people based on memory, imagination, and observation.

They will focus on adding new information to their drawings of people, such as showing movement, or designing their outfits to tell a story.

We will also begin incorporating writing into art, with younger students using letters to create drawings and older students writing simple artist statements about what they have made.

In P.E. this month, students in grades PreK to 2nd will begin by performing the
underhand throw in non-dynamic practice
tasks, laying the foundation for the overhand
throw they will use in grades 3-5. In these
grades, they will practice the critical
elements needed to reach maturity of the
skill and ultimately towards using the skill in
small-sided tasks, game-play, and
environments where they are ultimately
aiming at targets and hitting them with
accuracy most of the time.
