What We Are Learning this Month:

In November, all students will learn and practice the proper underhand and overhand throwing forms in a variety of practice and lesson activities. The simplest way to remember throwing is SWING, STEP, THROW. Following these basic steps will help students execute throwing to the best of their ability. Students will also demonstrate their ability to catch a ball above or below their waist as well as with a partner in a variety of practice tasks and activities while being stationary or moving.

Ways families can support learning from home:

Using any throwable object in their home, families can practice throwing and catching with another person. Try catching an object at least 10 times, then practice throwing to an individual or target at least 10 times.
