Attendance Policy

Regular attendance is key to your child's success. Our goal is to support families in ensuring that each child reaches their full potential.

- MSDE school year requires 180 days of instruction to complete a school calendar year.
- PGCPS requires that after 4 absences classroom teachers contact the parent.
- At GNS after 5 days one of our attendance team personnel will reach out to you.
- A child is considered chronically absent if they miss 10% of the enrolled days (ex. 45 days enrolled, absent 4 days they are chronically absent.)

Attendance FAQs

- Unexcused and excused absences are still absences in the eyes of the state.
 Absence notes do not removes absences from a students record.
- Excused absences allow for teachers to provide make up work.
- Teachers are <u>NOT</u> required to provide make up work for unexcused absences.
- Absence notes are required within <u>3 days</u>
 of the students return to school. Must be
 dated, signed and list the absence reason.

Tardies/Early Dismissal

- After 3 tardies in a week the teacher will reach out the parent.
- Though not an absence in the system, chronic tardiness impacts student performance.
- Instructional time is being missed that can not be made up and missing assignments are not required to be made up.
- In secondary grade levels early dismissals can result in absences.
